1. Second Roppongi branch, “GiGO Roppongi Imoaraizaka,” now open

On the 8th, located a minute’s walk from Tokyo Metro Roppongi Station (Exit 3), the newly opened “GiGO Roppongi Imoaraizaka” specializes in claw machines and boasts an open-air terrace entrance equipped with digital signage. Paired with “GiGO Roppongi” across the street (opened December 2025), these are the only two amusement arcades in the entire Roppongi area. Visitors can split their time between both locations, especially with the original branch’s newly expanded capsule toy corner. The new spot is already generating major foot traffic from both local and overseas visitors.

2. “Studio Coffret Chiba Sakuragi Studio” now open in Chiba city

On the 17th, “Studio Coffret Chiba Sakuragi Studio” is now open in Wakaba ward, the brand’s fourth private photography studio in Chiba Prefecture. Located in a peaceful, park-filled residential area popular with families, the studio offers a relaxed environment where children can be photographed at their own pace. Embracing the concept “Lien Étoilé” (the connection of starlight), the venue is gaining traction for capturing children’s natural, candid moments. Driven by repeat customers, pre-bookings have smashed expectations by over 300%, putting the new location off to a flying start.

Thanks to pre-open bookings blasting past expectations, the new studio is off to a highly successful start.

4. “GiGO” and “Little Planet” now open in Hanoi, Vietnam
